- Area in which residual clays are likely to be found.
- Areas in which outcrops were examined.
- Lake and some glacial clays, mostly cream-burning.
- Cincinnati shale, cream-burning. Does not outcrop at all points owing to heavy drift covering.
- Estuarine clays and a few glacial clays. Mostly cream-burning.
- Maquoketa shale, weathers to a yellow, red-burning clay.
- More or less siliceous, red or brown-burning surface clays, of loess, glacial or stream type. The individual deposits of ranging extent.
