



- SOILS**
- Pa** Light sandy soil, level valley bottom land; forest trees mostly jack pine.
 - Pa1** Sandy loam, with gravel or sand subsoil; level valley bottom land; forest trees, dense jack pine with some scrub oak.
 - Ril** Sandy and silt loams, with sandy or stony subsoil; level valley bottom land; forest trees, dense hard woods and white pine, some prairies with dark surface soil.
 - Msl** Sandy loam, with sand subsoil; level bottom of Chippewa River; forest trees, hard woods and pine.
 - Cl** Sandy and silt loams with some stone; hilly swamp land containing some swamp and ponds; forest of dense hard woods, hemlock, pine.
 - Ksl** Silt loam, containing some stone; gently sloping well drained land; forest trees, dense hard woods and pine.
 - tl** Sandy loam, containing some gravel and stone; nearly level land; forest trees, mainly pine.
 - Clu** Sandy and silt loams, having some stone in surface or subsoil; undulating land with swamps and ponds; forest trees, dense hard woods and white pine.
 - Clu1** Silt loam, with some stone; gently sloping well drained land; forest trees, dense hard woods and pine.
 - Sl** Silt loam, (less soil); undulating slopes and uplands; forest trees, dense hard woods mixed with white pine.
 - Al** Sandy and silt loams; hilly and sloping uplands; forest trees mainly light growth of hard woods with some pine.
 - Wsl** Wet silt and sand, with much limestone, much wet peat; flat undrained land; tamarack cedar and larch hard woods; marsh grass, orange, cranberry and moss.
