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## INTRODUCTION

Man's effect on ground water is rapidly gaining attention in the environmental studies of today. An ever-increasing number of people are becoming aware of the need for accurate and detailed ground-water information. The quantity and quality of ground water are of vital concern to a diverse group, including the city and rural planner, the farmer, the industrialist, and the homeowner. Since ground water was first mentioned in Foster and Whitney's report in 1851, a great deal of material has been compiled. The purpose of this bibliography and index is to help those concerned with ground water locate these references.

This bibliography incorporates, and is an expansion of, Ground-water Investigation Index of Wisconsin compiled by this author and published by the University of Wisconsin Water Resources Center in 1971. The bibliography contains 521 entries covering the period 1851 through 1972. It was compiled from a review of the following source materials: reports in professional and trade journals and magazines, reports and studies in federal and state agency files, and theses and unpublished material in the University of Wisconsin-Madison libraries. The search was supplemented by questionnaires about unpublished material which were sent to schools and agencies outside of Madison. In the initial stage of the search, the following bibliographies were used:

Bibliography of North American Geology, 1732-1969 (U.S. Geol. Survey);  
Abstracts of North American Geology, 1970-1971 (U.S. Geol. Survey);  
Selected Water Resources Abstracts, 1968-1972 (Water Resources  
Scientific Information Center).

The published bibliographies on ground water in the United States which were used in the search are listed separately on page 3.

The bibliography lists published and unpublished reports and studies committee reports, and student theses. In general, articles containing any information pertaining to Wisconsin's ground water, its occurrence, movement, relationship to the environment, quantity, quality, use, and management, were included. The publications which describe the results of the field work done in Wisconsin, but do not specify the location, were not included in the bibliography. Other exceptions are data on well drilling, findings of investigations of ground-water pollution cases, and reports of private consulting and engineering firms scattered throughout the state in local files. The data on well drilling is on file at the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey, 1815 University Avenue, Madison (well logs) and at the Division of Environmental Protection, Private Water Supply Section, Pyare Square Building, 4610 University Avenue, Madison (well-drillers' reports). Unpublished reports of the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey are listed separately at the end of the country index. Information about on-going projects can be obtained at the Survey.

The references are arranged alphabetically by author. Multiple author listing is provided only for those publications dealing directly with ground water within the state. The names of the junior authors are alphabetically interfiled and cross referenced to the first author (see also). An abbreviation in the upper right corner of each entry indicates where the reference is located in Madison.

The indexes are differentiated by color: subject index - yellow, county index - green, general index - pink, and chronological index - blue.
